

COMMITTEE TERM PLAN

The 5 voting members should serve 3-year terms. A voting member may serve a maximum of 2 consecutive 3-year terms. A member is eligible to serve multiple terms over time as long as they do not serve more than 2 consecutive 3-year terms.

Year 2 has 1 rotating off and 1 new member. Year 3 has 2 rotating off and 2 new members. Year 4 repeat of year 2 and year 5 a repeat of year 3, and so on. See the table below:
